November 13, 2013

The Commissioners' Court of Taylor County met in Special Called Session on November 13, 2013, with the following members present:

1. Judge Downing A. Bolls Jr., County Judge
2. Randy Williams, Commissioner, Precinct 1
3. Kyle Kendrick, Commissioner, Precinct 2
4. Stan Egger, Commissioner, Precinct 3
5. Chuck Statler, Commissioner, Precinct 4

When the following motions were heard:

1. Judge Bolls convened the Court in Special Called Session at 9:00 a.m.

2. Commissioner Statler made a motion to adopt the agenda. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Williams and carried unanimously.

3. Kristi Allyn, Elections Administrator presented the election results from the recent joint constitutional amendment elections. Ms. Allyn reported that 10,948 citizens cast ballots. This was the first election under the new state identification mandate law; only 5 voters arrived at polling places without proper identification. The Court does not have the responsibility to canvass the results of the various school bond elections held in districts around the county. Commissioner Kendrick made a motion to approve the canvass of the votes for the Constitutional Amendment Election as presented by the Elections Administrator. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Williams and carried unanimously. [Exhibit]

4. Commissioner Kendrick made a motion to adjourn. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Williams and carried unanimously. The meeting was adjourned at 9:13 a.m.
