

Taylor County Commissioners' Court

September 2, 2014

The Commissioners' Court of Taylor County met in Special Session on September 2, 2014, with the following members present:

1. Judge Downing A. Bolls Jr., County Judge
2. Randy Williams, Commissioner, Precinct 1
3. Kyle Kendrick, Commissioner, Precinct 2
4. Stan Egger, Commissioner, Precinct 3
5. Chuck Statler, Commissioner, Precinct 4

When the following motions were heard:

1. Judge Bolls convened the Court in a public hearing at 10:00 a.m.

2. Judge Bolls stated the purpose of the public hearing was to gather input from the public regarding the proposed budget and tax rate for fiscal year 2015.

Ms. Marian Ermis asked the Court various questions related to the necessity for the increase and comparison to budget totals for fiscal year 2014. The Court explained the reason for the increases to the budget due to increase costs in general, diminishing funding from the State of Texas without corresponding decreases in mandated responsibility and migration of homeowners to the unincorporated areas of Taylor County. Ms. Ermis believed she had received conflicting information from the Central Appraisal District on the effective date of her "over 65 tax freeze". Judge Bolls agreed to accompany her to the District's offices.


There were no other members of the public wishing to speak. [Exhibit]
