The Commissioners' Court of Taylor County met in Special Session on September 16, 2014, with the following members present:

1. Judge Bolls convened the Court in open session at 9:00 a.m.

2. Commissioner Statler made a motion to adopt the agenda for the meeting of September 16, 2014 as printed and posted. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Kendrick and carried unanimously.

3. Kristi Allyn County Elections Administrator presented the vote tabulation for the Special Election held on September 9, 2014 for Senate District 28. There were 743 votes cast out of potential 20,000 eligible voters. Commissioner Egger made a motion to approve the results of the election as canvassed and presented. 4. Kristi Allyn County Elections Administrator presented an proposed order for approval calling a General Election for November 4, 2014. Kristi Allyn County Elections Administrator presented the list she has developed for the presiding and alternate judges, the early voting ballot board and central counting judge and alternate for the November 4, 2014 General Election. 6. Kristi Allyn County Elections Administrator presented the early voting and mobile voting schedule for the General Election November 4, 2014. The number of mobile voting locations has been scaled back dramatically as senior centers are using mail ballots and will provide transportation to the voting centers. 
