The Commissioners' Court of Taylor County met in Special Session on August 12, 2015, with the following members present:

1. Judge Downing A. Bolls Jr., County Judge
2. Randy Williams, Commissioner, Precinct 1
3. Kyle Kendrick, Commissioner, Precinct 2
4. Stan Egger, Commissioner, Precinct 3
5. Chuck Statler, Commissioner, Precinct 4

When the following motions were heard:

1. Judge Bolls convened the Court in open session at 10:00 a.m.


2. Commissioner Statler made a motion to adopt the agenda for the meeting of August 12, 2015.

3. Commissioner Egger made a motion to declare a vacancy in the position of Taylor County Court at Law #2. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Williams and carried unanimously.

4. The Court discussed options in the process to fill the unexpired term for the position of Judge, Taylor County Court at Law #2. Options included appointing a retired or visiting judge or accepting applications for the position. Commissioner Statler covered the legal aspects of the appointment as found in Chapter 25 of the Texas Government Code and submitted the attached position advertisement. Each member of the Court stated their desire the appointment be the most seamless and quickest transition possible. Commissioner Williams made a motion to begin taking applications in accordance with the job announcement just outlined; advertising the position on the 16th and 23rd of August, and accept applications for thirteen working days with the close date of August 28.. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Egger and carried unanimously. [Exhibit]
