

Taylor County Commissioners' Court

July 19, 2016

The Commissioners' Court of Taylor County met in an Emergency Session on July 19, 2016, with the following members present:

1. Judge Downing A. Bolls Jr., County Judge
2. Randy Williams, Commissioner, Precinct 1
3. Kyle Kendrick, Commissioner, Precinct 2
4. Stan Egger, Commissioner, Precinct 3
5. Chuck Statler, Commissioner, Precinct 4

When the following motions were heard:

1. Judge Bolls convened the Court in open session at 10:00 a.m.

2. Commissioner Williams made a motion to approve the agenda as printed and posted. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Kendrick and carried unanimously.

3. Sheriff Bishop presented an Interlocal Agreement with Burnet County to house Taylor County inmate overflow. He informed the Court that Burnet County could take up to 30 female prisoners at \$35.00 per day. He would be sending 20 female inmates immediately; utilizing two 15 passenger vans and 4 deputies. Commissioner Statler made a motion to approve the Interlocal Agreement with Burnet County to house Taylor County inmate overflow at \$35.00 per day. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Williams and carried unanimously. [Exhibit]

4. Sheriff Bishop presented an Interlocal Agreement with Scurry County to house Taylor County inmate overflow. He informed the Court that Scurry County could take up to 8 female prisoners at \$45.00 per day. Commissioner Kendrick made a motion to approve the Interlocal Agreement with Scurry County to house Taylor County inmate overflow at \$45.00 per day. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Williams and carried unanimously. [Exhibit]

5. Commissioner Williams made a motion to adjourn. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Kendrick and carried unanimously. The meeting was adjourned at 10:26 a.m.
