The Commissioners' Court of Taylor County met in Regular Session on May 29, 2018, with the following members present:

When the following motions were heard:

1. Judge Bolls convened the Court in open session at 10:00 a.m.

2. Chaplain Terry Lopez, from the local VFW Post gave the invocation and Commissioner Williams led the Court in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America.

3. Commissioner Kendrick made a motion to approve the minutes of the meetings held on May 15, 2018 and May 23, 2018 and to adopt the agenda for the meeting of May 29, 2018 as printed and posted. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Williams and carried unanimously.
