

Taylor County Commissioners' Court

September 11, 2012

The Commissioners' Court of Taylor County met in Regular Session on September 11, 2012, with the following members present:

1. Judge Downing A. Bolls Jr., County Judge
2. Randy Williams, Commissioner, Precinct 1
3. Kyle Kendrick, Commissioner, Precinct 2
4. Stan Egger, Commissioner, Precinct 3
5. Chuck Statler, Commissioner, Precinct 4

When the following motions were heard:

1. Judge Bolls convened the Court in open session at 10:00 a.m.

2. Commissioner Randy Williams gave the invocation and Commissioner Kendrick led the Court in the Pledge of Allegiance.

3. Commissioner Statler made a motion to approve the minutes of the meetings held on August 20, August 28, and September 4, 2012 and to adopt the agenda for the meeting of September 11, 2012 as printed and posted. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Williams and carried unanimously.

4. Commissioner Kendrick made a motion to approve budget transfers as recommended by the Auditor. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Egger and carried unanimously. [Exhibit]

5. Commissioner Williams made a motion to approve bills from the following funds and to order them paid according to minutes of the accounts. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Kendrick and carried unanimously. [Exhibit]

6. Deputy Sheriff John Cummins presented the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program for approval. Each year Taylor County participates in this grant with the City of Abilene. The proceeds are used to purchase equipment for law enforcement. This year the Sheriff's Office plans to spend the proceeds to purchase "in car" cameras, Glock pistols and ballistic vests. The amount awarded to Taylor County is \$23,988.50. Commissioner Williams made a motion to approve the application to receive the Justice Assistance Grant partnering with the City of Abilene. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Kendrick and carried unanimously. [Exhibit]




