

Taylor County Commissioners' Court

November 15, 2012

The Commissioners' Court of Taylor County met in Regular Session on November 15, 2012, with the following members present:

1. Judge Downing A. Bolls Jr., County Judge
2. Randy Williams, Commissioner, Precinct 1
3. Kyle Kendrick, Commissioner, Precinct 2
4. Stan Egger, Commissioner, Precinct 3
5. Chuck Statler, Commissioner, Precinct 4

When the following motions were heard:

1. Judge Bolls convened the Court in open session at 8:45 a.m.

2. Commissioner Statler made a motion to convene and adopt the agenda as printed and posted. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Williams and carried unanimously.

3. Judge Bolls announced that the purpose of the meeting was to canvass the votes from the General Election held on November 6, 2012.

Kristi Allyn, Elections Administrator reported that 43,263 people cast votes in the election. Approximately 68% voted during Early Voting and 32% voted on Election Day.

Ms. Allyn presented the results by voting precinct to the members of the Court. The Court found no questions in the votes cast or the results. Commissioner Williams made a motion to accept the election results as presented. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Kendrick and carried unanimously. [Exhibit]

4. Commissioner Kendrick made a motion to adjourn. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Egger and carried unanimously. The meeting was adjourned at 8:55 a.m.
