December 18, 2012

The Commissioners' Court of Taylor County met in Regular Session on December 18, 2012, with the following members present:

When the following motions were heard:

1. Judge Bolls convened the Court in open session at 10:00 a.m.

2. Mary Glover, Priest of St. Mark's Episcopal gave the invocation and Commissioner Williams led the Court in the Pledge of Allegiance.

3. Commissioner Statler made a motion to approve the minutes of the meeting held on December 4, 2012 and to adopt the agenda for the meeting of December 18, 2012 as printed and posted. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Williams and carried unanimously.

4. Commissioner Kendrick made a motion to approve bills from the following funds and to order them paid according to minutes of the accounts. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Egger and carried unanimously. [Exhibit]

5. Lesa Crosswhite, County Treasurer presented the November 2012 Treasurer's Report for approval. The average interest rate for Tex Pool was 0.1564% and Tex Pool Prime was 0.1766%. Beginning balance for the General Fund was \$21,027,675.81; after receipts and disbursements the ending balance was \$21,519,389.79. Beginning balance for all funds was \$34,789,556.21; the ending balance was \$35,602,330.58. Commissioner Williams made a motion to approve the November 2012 Treasurer's Report as presented. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Egger and carried unanimously. [Exhibit]

6. Richard Greenawalt, County Purchasing Agent reported that a Harbor Generator needed to be removed from the Sheriff's Department inventory and declared surplus. Commissioner Egger made a motion to approve the generator as surplus property. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Statler and carried unanimously. [Exhibit]
