


TAYLOR COUNTY, TEXAS

ORDER PROHIBITING THE USE OF FIREWORKS ON COUNTY ROADS AND COUNTY ROAD RIGHTS OF WAY

Whereas, the Commissioners' Court finds that the use of fireworks on county roads and county road rights of way is dangerous to public safety, the Commissioners' Court hereby adopts the following order, effective immediately:

1. A person commits an offense if he or she intentionally, knowingly, or recklessly detonates, ignites, or in any way uses fireworks on a county road or in the right-of-way of a county road.
2. An offense under this Order is a Class C Misdemeanor punishable by a fine up to \$500.00.
