

Notice of Tax Revenue Increase

The TAYLOR COUNTY COMMISSIONERS' COURT conducted public hearings on August 15, 2018 and August 21, 2018 on a proposal to increase the total tax revenues of TAYLOR COUNTY from properties on the tax roll in the preceding year by 6.096499 percent.

The total tax revenue raised last year at last year's tax rate of 0.603100 for each \$100 of taxable value was \$43,881,728.40.

The total tax revenue proposed to be raised this year at the proposed tax rate of 0.609100 for each \$100 of taxable value, excluding tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year, is \$46,615,193.68.

The total tax revenue proposed to be raised this year at the proposed tax rate of 0.609100 for each \$100 of taxable value, including tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year, is \$47,655,664.52.

The Taylor County Commissioners' Court is scheduled to vote on the tax rate that will result in that tax increase at a public meeting to be held on September 4, 2018 at Taylor County Commissioners Court, 300 Oak Street, 2nd Floor, Abilene, TX 79602 at 10:00 AM.

The Taylor County Commissioners' Court proposes to use the increase in total tax revenue for the purpose of general operations, including salary, benefits, equipment, administration of justice, public safety, meeting unfunded & partially funded state mandates and payment on bond indebtedness.
