**ORDER SETTING TAX RATE AND LEVYING TAXES – MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS**

On the 1st day of September, 2020, at a meeting of the Commissioners' Court of Taylor County, Texas, the Court considered setting tax rates for the 2021 fiscal year.


**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED** that the Maintenance and Operations (M&O) tax rate for the 2021 fiscal year is 57.02 cents per \$100 of valuation. This rate, along with the separately adopted interest and sinking tax rate, is an adoption of the 2020 certified No-New-Revenue Tax Rate.


THIS TAX RATE WILL RAISE MORE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS THAN LAST YEAR'S TAX RATE. ADDITIONAL TAXES RAISED WILL BE GENERATED FROM NEW PROPERTY ADDED TO THE TAX ROLL THIS YEAR.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that taxes are levied for the 2021 fiscal year.



**ORDER SETTING TAX RATE AND LEVYING TAXES – INTEREST AND SINKING**

On the 1st day of September, 2020, at a meeting of the Commissioners' Court of Taylor County, Texas, the Court considered setting tax rates for the 2021 fiscal year.


**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED** that the Interest and Sinking (I&S) tax rate for the 2021 fiscal year is 4.81 cents per \$100 of valuation. This rate, along with the separately adopted maintenance and operations tax rate, is an adoption of the 2020 certified No-New-Revenue Tax Rate.

This rate will fund all debt service requirements for the 2021 fiscal year for Taylor County, including scheduled payments on the 2017 Expo Construction Bond and the 2019 Election Equipment Tax Note.


**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that taxes are levied for the 2021 fiscal year.
