

JURY SERVICE COVID-19 PRE-SCREENING QUESTIONNAIRE

Dear Prospective Juror:

As part of the court's ongoing measures to protect against the spread of the COVID-19 disease, we ask that you complete the following before reporting for Jury Service. **Bring this completed questionnaire with you.**

1. SYMPTOMS EXPERIENCED 14 DAYS PRIOR TO DATE OF JURY SERVICE: check any that apply to YOU or A MEMBER OF YOUR HOUSEHOLD

Fever Loss of taste or smell Cough Headache Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing

Nausea, diarrhea, or vomiting Chills Muscle or body aches Sore throat Fatigue

Congestion or runny nose Flu like symptoms

I certify that NONE of the symptoms above have been experienced by me or a member of my household in the last 14 days.

IF YOU ARE EXPERIENCING ANY OF THE ABOVE SYMPTOMS, PLEASE RETURN THE EXEMPTION CARD TO THE DISTRICT CLERK'S OFFICE.

2. CONTACT HISTORY - check any that apply to YOU or A MEMBER OF YOUR HOUSEHOLD:

I or a member of my household has been diagnosed with COVID-19 within the past 30 days;

I or a member of my household has been in close contact with someone exposed to or infected with COVID-19 in the last 30 days;

I or a member of my household are currently on a watch list or self-quarantining because of possible COVID-19 exposure;

NONE of the above apply.

IF YOU ARE EXPERIENCING ANY OF THE ABOVE SYMPTOMS, PLEASE RETURN THE EXEMPTION CARD TO THE DISTRICT CLERK'S OFFICE, OR CALL 325-674-1308 BEFORE REPORTING.

3. COVID-19 RELATED EXCUSE OR RESCHEDULE - Individuals who are over age 65 and individuals with serious underlying health conditions, such as high blood pressure, chronic lung disease, diabetes, obesity, asthma, and those whose immune systems are compromised, such as by chemotherapy for cancer or other conditions requiring such therapy, are considered to be vulnerable populations and may request to reschedule or be excused from jury service at this time.

IF YOU ARE REQUESTING TO BE EXCUSED PLEASE RETURN THE EXEMPTION CARD TO THE DISTRICT CLERK'S OFFICE. IF YOU WANT YOUR SERVICE DATE BE RESCHEDULED DUE TO A COVID-19 RELATED REASON, CALL THE DISTRICT CLERK'S OFFICE at 325-674-1308

4. FACE COVERINGS:

Prospective jurors are required to wear a face covering for the duration of jury service. Individuals are encouraged to bring a cloth face covering with them. If an individual does not have a cloth face covering, a disposable face mask will be provided.
